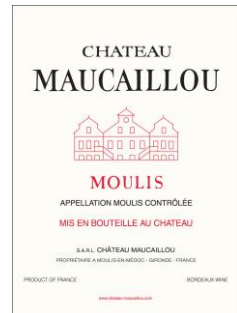

Nicely fragrant Cabernet fruit, quite lifted and elegant but could have more depth. Drink 2014-18.



eROBERTPARKER.com - Mai 2011

Robert PARKER
Note : **86-88**

The 2010's deep plum/ruby color is accompanied by a subtle note of minerality intermixed with fresh acids, sweet tannin and excellent concentration, suggesting this wine should drink nicely for 10-12 years

Neal MARTIN
Note: **88-90**

This has good intensity on the nose with blackberry, oyster shell and dark plum, showing nice poise and focus. The palate is medium-bodied, slightly chewy on the entry, good weight with a firm masculine, cedar-infused finish. Fine

Acidity and fresh fruit are out of balance with smoky wood. The wine will need to integrate in the coming months, although all the elements are there.

Mid crimson. Very sweet and voluptuous start then just the merest hint of sandpaper and great, supple, ripe tannins. The merest hint of greenness on the finish but overall pretty lovely. Fresh and 'feminine' though there is no shortage of tannin

Deep; less saturated than some; more strawberry notes and mineral and wet rocks; palate sweet entry and has depth here; ripe fruit and open. This should be good. Chewy, dense and grippy but has flesh. Sappy and concentrated.

Offers a solid core of plum and anise framed by black tea and backed by a supple, fine-grained finish. This puts on weight nicely while it airs in the glass, but stays supple and gentle overall. Drink now through 2017

Mid depth; glossy; red fruits, some wet rock and chalky qualities; spice and earth with blackcurrant highlights; blackcurrant fruit again on the palate, earthy notes and quite lot of oak here too. Bags of guts – lots of chewy material. Will need 5 years to meld and last a while. Good value as ever.

Ripe plums and berries with hints of flower. Full body, chewy tannins and a long finish. Needs time to soften but beautiful. Better in 2015.

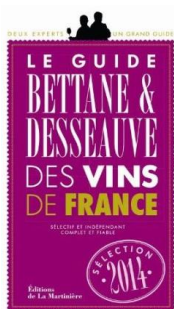

Robe rouge rubis. Bouquet épanoui et élégant, de bonne intensité. Agréables caractère fruité avec des notes de fraises, framboise et chocolat noir. A l'aération le bouquet se révèle de manière épanouie et se relève des fruits confits, assimilable à une touche de douceur olfactive. La mise en bouche est filigrane et juteuse. Corps parfaitement équilibré et légèrement gras. Les tannins sont fondus, légèrement granuleux et se révèlent lentement. La structure les seconde idéalement pour assurer les arrières. Un vin à décanter environ 30 minutes. Maintenant – 2030.
