Dans sa version de 2025, Maucaillou porte bien son suffixe : les graves à gros cailloux, qui composent une partie de son terroir et chauffent les raisins en été, ont parfaitement joué leur rôle. Si on se fie à la dégustation, les merlots et les cabernets sauvignon ont été récoltés à parfaite maturité. On y décèle un parfum de pétale de rose, le réconfort de la confiture de framboises, une pointe de fraîcheur qui rappelle l'huile essentielle de patchouli. L'attaque tout en souplesse se déploie sur un milieu de bouche suave, souple, grâce à des tanins mûrs qui déposent une élégante finale de bois de santal.

Powerful rich purple colour, high cloves, spiced cocoa bean and smoked earth, this has high extraction, walks the line but stays on the right side of bitter. Chalky tannins as it opens, allowing the fruit to appear. 30% new oak. Harvest 8 to 22 September.

Deep dark ruby garnet, opaque core, violet reflections, delicate edge brightening. Some nougat, dark berry fruit, a hint of herbs, somewhat restrained bouquet. Medium complexity, subtle plum fruit, integrated tannins, some nougat, needs time.

Red fruit but also vegetal, slightly stemmy aromatics lead into a palate that feels a touch rough around the edges, with raw tannins making their presence known. The wine nonetheless performs better than expected, perhaps the clay soils lend a moderating hand in the vintage's dry heat. There's enough underlying fruit to carry it, even if the structure remains a bit rugged for now.

Similar in composition to Chasse-Spleen, but rather different in personality. This is more red-fruited and with the accent more on the berries rather than the stone fruits. That said, with aeration I also find a damson or two. Sleek and silken in texture, with quite an ample frame, this is relaxed and well-composed, if lacking a little of the complexity of the greatest wines of the appellation. But technically accomplished nonetheless.
